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

Published in 1958, *Color, Communism and Common Sense*, by Manning Johnson (1908–1959), is a must read book. Johnson was a high-ranking Communist Party African-American. He became deeply involved in the Party because he truly believed Communists were sincerely interested in improving the condition of Black Americans.



After 10 years of dedicated service to the Communist Party, Johnson realized that Communists weren't the least bit interested in improving the condition of Black people. He discovered Communists wanted to use Blacks as a "political dupe" in their quest for power. Manning eventually left the Party and became an anti-communist and informant for the government.

Johnson warned: “... *setting up situations that bring about racial bitterness, violence and conflict; putting forth demands so unrealistic that race relations are worsened; attacking everybody in disagreement as reactionaries, fascists, Klu Kluxers among Whites and Uncle Toms among Negroes, constitutes the red’s [Communist’s] pattern of operation.*”

The Left wants us to close our eyes to the progress our nation has made in race relations. Without question, the racism that occurs in our country today pales in comparison to the racism that existed in Frederick Douglass’ time. We have come a long way. There’s more work to be done.

Father of Communism (Karl Marx) vs. America’s Greatest Liberty Messenger (Frederick Douglass)

Karl Marx and Frederick Douglass, two key 19th-century figures, were both born in 1818. Marx was born to a middle-class family in Germany. His father was a lawyer, and his mother came from a wealthy business family. Marx grew up in a lavish home, was given a private education, and married a rich heiress. Living off of his wife, Jenny, colleague Friedrich Engels, and his wealthy uncle Benjamin Philips, Marx never worked a real job in his entire life – a perfect example of white privilege.

On the other hands, Douglass was born into slavery in Maryland. He never knew his father. He was separated from his mother at birth. Working on a different plantation, Douglass saw his mother only four or five times in his entire life. To visit her son, Douglass’ mother walked 12 miles each way after working all day in the fields, arriving by evening and departing before daybreak. She died when Douglass was 10 years old.

Douglass had no formal education. To learn to read and write, Douglass started his own homeschooling program while a slave boy. A slave for 20 years, Douglass experienced hunger, abandonment, extreme poverty, forced labor, dehumanization, whippings, no freedom and false imprisonment. Overcoming these conditions, by the time of his death in 1895 Douglass amassed \$300,000 in savings – over \$10 million in today’s money.

A white privilege poster child, Marx’s writings about oppression were simply unproven theories.

A former slave, Douglass’ philosophy about oppression was based on his life experiences.

How is it that a growing number of young Americans have become followers of Marxism, instead of Douglass-ISM? Obviously, it’s because they have never heard the compelling liberty message of Douglass.

If you are serious about dismantling CRT, then you must learn to leverage Douglass’ liberty message. Marxists have no answer for Douglass, and they never will.

ASSERTION #1:

Black People are Perpetual Helpless Victims of White Racism

Speaking to an audience of Boston abolitionists in 1862, Douglass stated that Blacks should not be treated as a special group because of their past enslavement: *“Do nothing with us, by us, or for us as a particular class ... the broadest and bitterest of the Black man’s misfortune is the fact that he is everywhere regarded and treated as an exception to the principles and maxims which applied to other men.”*

Douglass continued, *“We utterly repudiate all invidious distinctions, whether in our favor or against us and ask only for a fair field and no favor.”*

Douglass answered the question, “What shall be done with the Negro?” in his 1865 speech “What the Black Man Wants.”

Douglass said emphatically: *“What I ask for the Negro is not benevolence, not pity, not sympathy, but simply justice[.] ... Everybody has asked the question, and they learned to ask it early of the abolitionists, “What shall we do with the Negro?” I have had but one answer from the beginning. Do nothing with us! Your doing with us has already played the mischief with us[.] ... [I]f the Negro cannot stand on his own legs, let him fall also. All I ask is, give him a chance to stand on his own legs! ... Just let him alone! – your interference is doing him a positive injury.”*

Have you found it interesting that, in their effort to attack and label White Conservatives as ‘perpetual racists,’ White liberals exclude themselves. They claim they are somehow different. They highlight that they aren’t racist. They contend White liberals are friends and champions of Black people, fighting to free their Black brothers and sisters from White oppression. This is a diabolical illusion – a camouflage of Marxist-liberals to use Blacks as political pawns to advance their cause to divide Americans.

ASSERTION #2:

White People Are Innately Racist With No Redeeming Qualities

In 1848, 10 years after his escape from slavery, Frederick Douglass wrote to his former slave master, Thomas Auld. He urged him to repent from his racist ways, saying, *“I shall make use of you as a means of exposing the character of the American church and clergy – and a means of bringing this guilty nation with yourself to repentance.”*

As a result of Douglass' firm insistence and the power of Divine repentance, Auld freed all 400 of his slaves in less than a year, 15 years before the signing of the Emancipation Proclamation.

In 1849, Douglass wrote to Auld a second time: *"I have been told by a person intimately acquainted with your affairs, and upon whose word I can rely, that you have ceased to be a slaveholder, and have emancipated all of your slaves, except for my old grandmother, who is now too old to sustain herself in freedom; and that you have taken her from the desolate hut in which she formerly lived, into your own kitchen, and are providing for her in a manner becoming a man and a Christian. This, Sir, is good news ... It proves that the agitation of the subject of slavery does not hinder, if it does not help, the emancipation of slaves at the South."*

Douglass underlines an effective strategy to redeem a racist: **"agitation and Divine repentance."** Racism in the United States today pales in comparison to the racism that existed in Douglass' time and in the 1950s and 1960s. Race relations in America have greatly improved, partly because of more open and honest dialogue and the discovery of shared values. The United States is not perfect, but it has always moved forward.

Today, Whites are passionately involved in criminal justice reform and improving failing Black schools. They actively participated and funded the Abolitionist and Civil Rights Movements. How is this altruistic behavior inherently racist? How is it that a White racist can't be redeemed from racism according to CRT? The transformation is never easy. It will be impossible for some and achievable for others. There is nothing too hard for God. He can redeem anyone.

Convinced that Blacks cannot provide for themselves, needing masters to rule and feed them, Marxist-liberals think their “instruction” and “social benevolence” can best improve the condition of Black people - instead of giving them Liberty.

ASSERTION #3:

There Are No Absolutes

I looked for it in her democratic Congress and her matchless Constitution – and it was not there. Not until I went into the churches of America and I heard her*

genius and power. America is great because America is good, and if America ever ceases to be good, America will cease to be great!”

Thank God for the literary legacy of Frederick Douglass to help us understand the truth, refute the lies and expose the cruel agenda of Marxism.

Frederick Douglass warned us in his 1850 speech, *The Nature of Slavery*, that:

“The first work of slavery is to mar and deface those characteristics of its victim which distinguish men from things, and persons from property. Its first aim is to destroy all sense of high moral and religious responsibility. It reduces man to a mere machine. It cuts him off from his Maker, it hides him from the laws of God, and leaves him to grope his way from time to eternity in the dark, under the arbitrary and despotic control of frail, depraved, and sinful fellowmen.”

By now you no doubt get the point. The “frail, depraved, and sinful fellowmen” of today are Marxist-liberals. Communism is slavery. It forces its citizens to become slaves of the state by changing their private worship from God to government.
